



## Summer Program – Legal Services Branch

The Legal Services Branch of the Ministry of Attorney General for British Columbia is hiring three students for summer 2018. These temporary articles are open to students currently in law school who will have completed their second year by May 1, 2018. Two positions are located in Victoria, and one is located in Vancouver.

The three summer positions will be litigation focussed, with the possibility of other legal work as well. Successful applicants will be responsible for any travel, accommodation and other costs related to residing in Victoria or Vancouver during the term of the employment.

These three positions may lead to articles for 2019-20, subject to satisfactory performance during the summer temporary articles and subject to budgetary approval. Applications for articles not linked to summer positions will be accepted from the middle of January to the end of February 2018. Details on applying for those positions will be available through the [Applying for Articles](#) page of our website starting on January 15, 2018

Initial interviews of shortlisted candidates outside of British Columbia will take place by telephone at a mutually convenient time shortly after the application deadline. Applicants outside of British Columbia who are selected for a second interview can be interviewed via Skype, however if they prefer to attend the second interview in person, they will be responsible for their own costs of attending the second interview.

### Application Requirements

In order for your application to be considered, you must submit the following documents. Do not submit any materials other than:

- Your resume, not to exceed three pages
- Transcripts - copies of your law school transcripts and any other post-secondary transcripts (official transcripts not required)
- Covering letter, not to exceed one page

Depending on the number of applications received, preliminary shortlisting may be done based on law school grades. Additional shortlisting will be based on the cover letter and resume.
