Letter of Permission (University of Manitoba students)

In order to receive credit, students must apply for a “Letter of Permission” at the Registrar’s Office one month prior to departing, and upon completing the program, submit an official transcript from Hebrew University (electronic copies not accepted).

Any fees paid toward the program will not be refunded (e.g. registration fee, fee associated with the letter of permission, flight, accommodation or tuition, etc.).

Housing

Passport

Canadian passports must be valid for at least six months beyond the date of the expected departure from the country. Please check the expiration of your passport and renew accordingly. Students with passports from other countries should check with their nearest consulate on any travel documents that might be required to travel to Israel.

Cost

Please note the currency; tuition, dorms, registration fee and deposit are paid in USD.

Airfare: \$1500-\$2000 CAD. Students book their own airfare.

Tuition (& Dorms): \$2920 USD. (Tuition \$2230 USD Dorms: \$690 USD) Tuition includes health insurance.

Living costs (meals, local transportation): \$1000-\$1600 CAD.

Letter of permission: \$70 CAD.

Required Reading: \$20 CAD ("Start-up Nation" by Dan Senor and Saul Singer.)

Registration Fee: \$80 USD.

Deposit: \$250 USD.

Total Cost: Approximately **\$6,600 - \$7,700 CAD**

We aim to offer the students a subsidy to cover 70-80% of the tuition cost (note: this does not include the cost of the dorms).

February 15, 2019 – Deadline to complete your application (including medical forms)

March 1, 2019 – Deposit deadline
