

PLEASE NOTE *RE PRIZES*:

Dean's Honour List - Pitblado Scholars: All students on the Dean's Honour List (comprising the top 10% of the class) for First Year and Second Year, **who return the following year, receive \$5,000.00 Pitblado Scholarships which are applied to the cost of their tuition.**

Course Prizes: The majority of courses and sections of courses have prizes awarded for the top students.

Third Year Multiple-Course Prizes: The following seven prizes are awarded in Third Year for top performance in multiple courses taken in all three years: (1) Tradition Law LLP Wealth and Succession Prize, (2) Irvin Goldman Prize, (3) Judge Ross A. Johnston Prize for Family Law, (4) Jane Evans, Q.C., Prize, (5) Honsa Family Prize in Intellectual Property Law, (6) Gerald W.
