



Step 4: Special Applications

The additional applications in this section include questions needed for specific bursaries. Please only complete the ones where you meet the eligibility requirements.

The special applications include the following:

- Supplemental Bursary Application: includes questions on extra-curricular activities, leadership experience, athletic involvement, memberships, and a question to identify students from a rural area in Canada.
- Armed Forces General Bursary Application: for students who are current members of the Canadian military or have past service, or have family or ancestors who have served in the Canadian military.
- William and Olga Danylyuk Bursary: ONLY for students who are current members of St. Andrew's College.
- Erin Nemy Bursary: for students who are interested in pursuing a career in journalism and have examples of work that has already been published.
- Jennifer M. Shay Bursary: for undergraduate students who have taken or will be taking field courses in Biological Sciences or Ecology.
- Work History Application: for students who have a history of full-time employment prior to the current academic year (students with summer time employment are not eligible).
- Accessibility Application: for students with accessibility / disability / medical issues.
- Faculty of Law Supplemental Bursary Application: additional information needed for consideration for Faculty of Law specific bursaries for students currently registered in the Faculty of Law.
- College of Medicine Supplemental Bursary Application: additional information needed for consideration for College of Medicine specific bursaries for students currently registered in the College of Medicine.

Bursary allocations are typically made in early November. If you are allocated a bursary, it will appear in AURORA. All bursaries are first applied to Winter Term tuition. If there is a credit, you will be able to request it after the course registration revision period for 2020-21.
